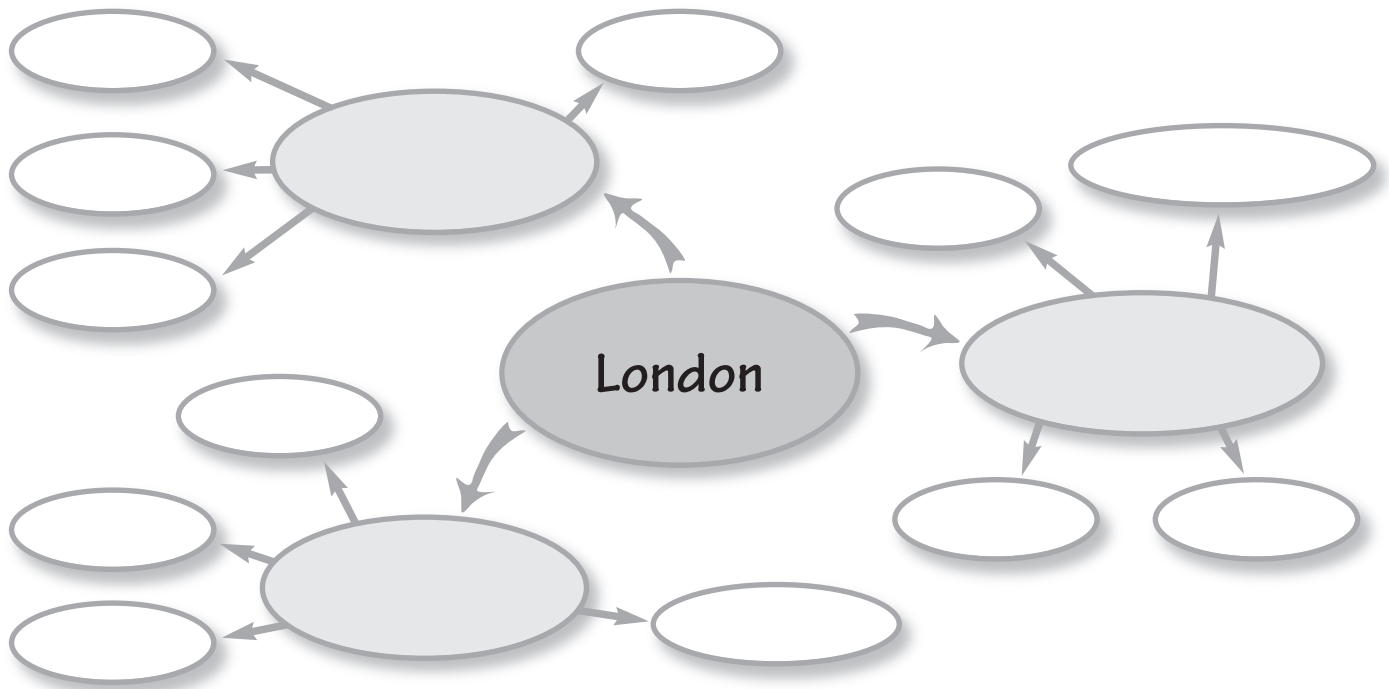


F4 London – A Collaborative Travel Diary

● Work on your own for 4–5 minutes. Try and make a mind map about London. One of you should volunteer to write the mind map on a transparency and present it to the class. Add ideas that other people have.



● Just in case you don't have any ideas: Here are some aspects you might add. Now mark two or three topics you could imagine writing a short paragraph about.



● Look at the mind map, pick a topic you think you can write some lines about and write a short text. Write the text in a personal style – as if you were there and you could really see and experience these things yourself. Then get together with three or four other students. Compare your texts and try to combine them. You have to find a) the order in which you want your pieces to be b) an introduction and a final sentence c) transition sentences between your texts. Now create one collaborative text – out of many, one!
